Gigapixel Wall Murals for Ocean Park, Hong Kong

We were featured in the Advertiser Business Journal on 11th November for creating giant focus-fused gigapixel photographs for the walls of the New Koala Attraction in Ocean Park, Hong Kong. Following an original order for one wall, we have now completed further orders for a total of eight walls, the largest being 40 metres wide by 7.5 metres high.

The koala exhibition called "Adventures in Australia" is a massive win for South Australia, particularly because Ocean Park has agreed to make the new exhibit just about SA. The exhibition will be opened in March 2015 and they are aiming to have 1000 visitors an hour for 10 hours a day, about eight million visitors a year. Read the Advertiser article here.
